OLD TESTAMENT: Isaiah 25: 6-9- Dave Parmenter

⁶On this mountain the LORD hosts will make for all peoples a feast of rich food a feast of well – aged wines, of rich food filled with marrow, of well – aged wines strained clear. ⁷ And he will destroy on n this mountain the shroud that is cast over all peoples, the sheet that covers all nations; he will

swallow up death forever. ⁸ Then the Lord GOD will wipe away the tears from all faces, and the disgrace of his people he will take away from all the earth, for the LORD has spoken. ⁹ It will be said on that day, Lo this is our God; we have waited for him, so that he might save us. NEW TESTAMENT: Mark 16: 1-8 – Dave Parmenter

When the Sabbath was over, Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James, and Salome bought spices so that they might go to anoint Jesus' body. ² And very early on the first day of the week, when the sun had risen they went to the tomb ³ they had been saying to one another, "Who will roll away the stone, for us from the entrance to the tomb?"⁴ when they looked up, they saw that the stone, which was very large, had already been rolled back.. ⁵ As they entered the tomb, they saw a young man dressed in a white robe sitting on the right side; and they were alarmed.⁶ But he said to them. Look, there is the place they laid him. ⁷ But go, tell his disciples and Peter, that he is going ahead of you to Galilee; there you will see him, just as he told you. ⁸ So they went out and fled from the tomb, for terror and amazement and seized them; and they said nothing to anyone, for they were afraid.
